CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Have you ever been reading a devotion and thought, how profound, I must remember this, only to let it slip away? Or maybe you put it away for later only to not give it another thought. I have, and sometimes years later, I'll find it and maybe even get a different message.

Here are excerpts from three I saved.

1. We all know we can find much wisdom in the 31 chapters of Proverbs. For example, Proverbs 1:7 says, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge". How would you translate "fear" in this verse? According to Bill Crowder, writing in *Our Daily Bread*, "The importance of 'the fear of the Lord' is seen in the fact that it is found eleven times in Proverbs and the challenge 'fear the Lord' another four times." Does this mean we are to be afraid of God? Not according to the Hebrew word, yirah, which is translated to fear in the verse. It means awe or reference or an attitude towards God that gives us a desire to obey Him. Thus, wisdom begins when we embrace the greatness of God and desire to honor Him.



2. Alyson Kieda, also writing for *Our Daily Bread*, uses Psalm 18:20-27 to talk about God's promise to David. We know God promised that David would always be loved, have a descendent on the throne, and that the Savior would be one of his descendants. David committed adultery and had a man killed. Why, then, was he "a man after God's own heart"? Kieda said because David had absolute faith in God and one example of his faith is when David as a young shepherd boy fought Goliath. Also, because David loved scripture and when he sinned, he repented and asked for God's for-

giveness; a huge lesson for us. No matter what, God loves us and like David, when we sin, we need to go to scripture, repent and seek forgiveness.



3. This last was written by Milligan Burroughs in D365. Read Ephesians 1:11-14. We all like bonuses. The bonus we have as Christians is "not only are we saved by our trust and hope in Christ, but we have received an inheritance. As children of God, that inheritance begins with the unexpected gift of the Holy Spirit in our lives. God doesn't just love us and redeem us but we have received a big bonus. The BONUS is God's Spirit remains with us!" So we have salvation plus the bonus of the constant presence of the Holy Spirit.

CHALLENGE: What have you put aside to reread? Look for some. Are you getting the same interpretation now?

Looking back, what did you miss that you now see was the hand of God? Each day look for all the big and small ways God is guiding your life.

PRAYER: God, please help me trust in your power and goodness. Help me see all the ways you are at work in my life each and every day. Amen.


