

## CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

### Are We A Praying Church? Part 3



Even though this is the last article on prayer for a while, does that mean the end? Obviously not. Prayer is the Alpha and Omega of our Christian walk with Christ. The beginning and the end and every step along the way.

We know the Bible says "rejoice always and pray continually (1 Thessalonians 5:16-17). Jesus said, "When you pray..... pray to your Father who is [always] present..." Mathew 6:5-6. So, we have a mandate to pray.

Have you ever noticed that a sure and quick way to get silence is to ask if anyone would pray? We can say or be told that "praying is simple, it's just talking to God" However, praying aloud can make us feel selfconscious, vulnerable and judged. And even sometimes praying alone can be a challenge. Sometimes we can't seem to find the right words, and sometimes we even forget to pray. Don't fret. Remember the disciples asked Jesus to teach them to pray, which probably means they struggled also. And Jesus did not rebuke them. He taught them what we refer to as "The Lord's Prayer" (Matt. 6:9-13 and Luke 11:2-4). Scripture tells us that the Holy Spirit is our help and intercedes for us. (Romans 8: 26-2) When we have no words, the spirit intervenes. Kyle Caudle said, "Unknown to us the Spirit could be praying through us, for us, and in us. In God's grace our lives are constantly surrounded by prayer" (D365, May 21, 2021).

In John 17, we find the "High Priestly Prayer." In other words, Jesus as the High Priest prays for His disciples and for us as we, too, are also disciples. This happened right before Jesus was arrested. Remember, the disciples still did not understand what was coming. Jesus' last gift to them was for them to hear Him proclaiming His love for them and His trust in them to carry out the mission He was entrusting to them without His presence. Do you think they were honored, afraid, confused, worried they would not be able to do as asked? Maybe all of these. Sometimes, as disciples we may be called upon to do something hard or something we are not sure we can do. Never forget, when Jesus calls upon us, He will give us what we need to complete this task. He loves us and has confidence we can do it, WITH GOD'S HELP. Keep praying.

#### PRAYER:

Holy Spirit, pray thru me when I do not have the words. Stay near to my heart and work thru me. And all God's children said,



**CHALLENGE:** Rise from a kneeling place and allow God's love to shine boldly thru you.
