

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

WHO or WHAT? or Who and What?



In the article, "The Better Question Believers Should Ask About God's Will", Jen Wilken said: "For the believer wanting to know God's will for her/his life, the first question to pose is not what should I do but who should I be?"

Briefly she says that:

Both questions are necessary but the order of asking is important. Who refers to the heart and what to actions. If we focus on what we do without addressing our hearts, we may do good but still have heart issues... envy, jealousy, egotism, being selfish, etc. Simply making better choices does not necessarily make us better people but being better people guides us to better choices. Anyone can make good choices. But, only people who have the Holy Spirit indwelling can make choices for the purpose of glorifying God

So WHO God wants me to be has to precede WHAT God wants me to do.

The Gospel teaches that we have God's mercy and grace by the work of the Holy Spirit. We are not to simply make better choices but to become better people (sanctification). Paul said, as believers we are "being transformed into Christ likeness" 2 Cor. 3:18. This means we should constantly be striving to be more like Jesus. The Holy Spirit is transforming us into WHO God wants us to be so we can better do WHAT He wants us to do. This means we should constantly be striving to be more like Jesus in heart first and then action.

I'll have to admit that this idea really made me stop and think. Most of the time, my prayers are what do you want me to do, God? How do you want me to approach....... Really, I know God wants my heart to be filled with the Holy Spirit. But do I check my heart before I act? What about you? Most of us probably concentrate on the WHAT and we certainly need to know what God want us to do and how. But I

CHALLENGE: you to let's first determine WHO God wants us to be and then the What. So, WHO and WHAT.

God, fill my heart with the Holy Spirit and guide my actions to glorify you and strive to further Your Kingdom. Amen.
